Prices have been reduced by between 25% and nearly 50% and this also reduces the weight of the packs which makes the postage considerably cheaper.*

## **ORDERING**

Funds may be sent by online bank transfer or PayPal (**PayPal users please be sure to follow all of my instructions below!**).

If you are using PayPal please DO NOT include any note at all whilst making the PayPal transaction. Make the transaction without adding a note and send the details of your order to me in a private email. PayPal will probably give me your shipping address when they send me the notification of your payment, but they don't always so please also include this in your private email to me. Please note that a PayPal transaction involves a fee which I require you to pay at your end and the details are given below of how to do this.

If you use online banking then please send me a private email after you have made the transfer to inform me of this so that I can keep an eye on the account to see when it arrives and you can then list the items you'd like and supply me with the shipping address in that same message.

If it is absolutely impossible for you to use either of these payment methods then please contact me privately.

Please note that just for the time being it is necessary for you to make your payment for the recordings first and to make your payment to cover the postage after the discs have been sent. I realise this is a pain but I have tried to work out various postage rates depending on the number of discs required and where they are being posted to but the language barrier has made this very difficult for me (I'm an Englishman living in Spain) so I shall write again after the pack has been mailed when I will know what the cost was. I only ever ask for the actual costs to be covered which you'll be able to verify for yourselves by the postmark when the pack arrives. As often as possible I re-use old packing materials and I have a good stock of these that should certainly see me through for a while, so for the moment I don't need to ask anything for the packing.

### **ONLINE BANK TRANSFER**

I believe that anyone with a UK bank account and online banking facilities is able to make a transfer without incurring any fee, though if you're not sure please check first. My banking details are -

If you have an option to insert a first name please NEVER put "Chris". The bank has been a PAIN over this because I'm known by my middle name and has rejected things made out in this name. Please use my initials AC (or Allan Christopher if very necessary, noting the correct spelling of "ALLAN" or they'll be unhappy about that too!).

I am not so sure about non-UK banks, but I believe that a hefty fee is likely to be incurred and it would be best to use PayPal if you don't have UK bank account, unless you know otherwise.

### **PAYPAL**

**Please follow these instructions so that your payment will be sent with the fee paid at your end. If this isn't followed properly and the payment is received with the fee deducted I shall have to return it and we'll need to start again.**

1. Log into your PayPal account and click on the "Send Money" tab (as usual).
2. Enter paypal@sounds-on-cd.co.uk and the appropriate amount. (Note that the prices I have given are all in sterling. There is no need to consider your own local currency, simply enter the sterling amount from the figures I've given you and make sure that the right hand box under the "Amount" header is set to "GBP – British Pounds".)
3. Select the right hand "Personal" tab below the "Amount boxes" - NOT the "Purchase" tab.
4. Tick the "Gift" tab.
5. Click "Continue" to reach the "Review your payment and send" section. Check the box "I will pay the fee" and then click the "Send Money" box to complete the transaction.
